DRESS CODE

Smooth soled shoes without heels must be worn on the green. Casual play does not require whites or club colours.

For all Championship events, members are required to wear whites or club colours with whites.

For V&D or Inter-club events, please refer to the V&D Handbook.

GAME RULES

- **All games under TLBC sanction will be conducted under the Conditions of Play as presented in the Games Management Manual.** Notice of events (except daily draws) will be posted two weeks prior to the event. Ten days will be allowed for entry. The draw will be made 3 days before the event and then posted. **Drop outs after the draw are discouraged.** If you must withdraw from an event after the teams have been drawn, inform a convenor. Generally, the convenor will select a spare from as close as possible to the top of the remaining Spares list but with due consideration for ranking equal or close to that of the drop-out. However, for championship events rules with respect to spares will be governed by the Conditions of Play for the event. **For sign-up events the Skips, as a courtesy, are asked to advise/remind their teams by phone. However, the ultimate responsibility for checking the draw sheets prior to the event rests with the individual members.** All questions related to the event must be directed to the convenor listed for that event. Club events take precedence over ordinary or casual play. At the discretion of the vent convenor open or practice games will be permitted during championship finals, V&D, or Interclub events. All draws are to be in accordance with tag board. Changes in playing positions may be made within a team following the draw. **Special note:** In the event of a “burnt end” in which the Jack is driven beyond the boundaries of the rink, the Jack will be re-positioned to a point on the centerline at a distance of 2 metres from the front ditch and the end will continue to completion.
- **Rules for the Cutthroat Leagues on Friday nights will be as the Conditions of Play for the League.**

SCORING SYSTEMS

- For Loonie and Toonie draws, total shot differentials are used to determine the winner
- For Tournaments and Leagues the scoring system will be 3 points for a win, 1 point for a tie and zero points for a loss, then total shot differential limited to +/- 10 in each game. If a tie still exists, ends will be counted. In club championship events, if a tie still exists after ends are counted there will be a playoff of 2 ends, with a sudden death end if necessary.
- For monthly leagues there may be rainouts. Prize money will be awarded if a minimum of 3 games are played, otherwise entry fees will be returned and the league will become a non-money event.
- For the Cutthroat Leagues the scoring will be total accumulated score of games played and score issued for weeks missed.

SPLITTING GAMES- The following games may be split between two members of the same ranking: any weekday normal draw, any Loonie or Toonie draw, any visitation and the Men versus Women event.

GAME DEFINITIONS

The following games are open to all members except as noted.

MORNING, AFTERNOON and WEEKEND DRAWS

Cut off time for joining is posted on the calendar as Draw time. Please arrive 15 minutes before the draw time to help set up the greens. Random draws are done to form teams of Triples, Pairs and Cutthroat. Triples games are 12 ends and Pairs are 14 ends. Length of game can be altered by consensus of the players playing on a individual rink. Games will commence immediately following the draw. On Monday afternoon “ Tea Between “ is served after 6 ends.

AUSTRALIAN PAIRS – July 3 (Random draw), May 28 (Chosen partner)

A pair’s game in which the order of play within each team alternates between Skip and Lead. In the first end, the Lead throws the first two bowls, the Skip throws the next four and then the Lead throws the last two. For the second end, the players remain at their respective ends. The Skip now

throws the first two bowls, the Lead throws the next four and then the Skip throws the last two. Play continues alternating in this manner through the remainder of the game. Players experience both positions. 3x10 ends. \$5.00 per person. Prizes according to number of entries. BYO Lunch.

CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP (Alex Davidson Trophy) – ALEX DAVIDSON MIXED PAIRS – August 10 start, August 12 Finals

Chosen partners, one male and one female. An event for up to 32 teams, morning and (possibly) afternoon draws of either 3x8 or 3x10 end games (dependent on number of registrants). The top four (4) teams advance to the finals. All pairs must be available for play on both days. Finals are 3x10 ends. No entry fee. BYO Lunch. Dress code.

CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP (Trophy event) – MIXED FOURS – June 11

Random draw with two men and two women on each team, if possible. Juniors are eligible only if they are ranked as Seconds or greater. 3x10 ends. No entry fee. BYO Lunch. Dress code.

CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP (Trophy event) - MEN'S PAIRS AND WOMEN'S PAIRS – Start date June 18, Finals August 6

Teams are selected by random draw. This event is not open to Novice bowlers. Juniors are eligible only if they are ranked as Seconds or greater. 18 end games with knockout format. Must be available on August 8. No entry fee. Dress code. Refer to Conditions of Play for further details as to scheduling of matches.

CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP (Trophy event) – SINGLES – Start date – June 24, Finals August 27

There are three championship levels: (a) Novice Singles, open only to first year bowlers. All players in this category compete together. (b) Colt/Sophomore Singles, open only to second and third year bowlers. All players in this category compete against each other. (c) Men's & Women's Singles. Not open to 1st year bowlers. Juniors are eligible only if they are ranked as Seconds or greater. Men and women compete separately. All levels are single knockout formats. All games to 21 points. All entrants must be available for the finals on August 27. For other scheduled dates convenors will accommodate players if they cannot make a scheduled date. No entry fee. Dress code for all matches.

CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP (Trophy event) – TRIPLES – MEN'S MCCARTHY – August 21

Open to all male members. Juniors are eligible only if they are ranked as Seconds or greater. This event is not open to Novice bowlers. Teams made up by random draw. 3x12 ends. No entry fee. BYOLunch. Dress code.

CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP (Trophy event) – TRIPLES – WOMEN'S FURZE – July 15

Open to all female members. Juniors are eligible only if they are ranked as Seconds or greater. This event is not open to Novice bowlers. Teams made up by random draw. 3x10 ends. No entry fee. BYOLunch. Dress code.

HARVEY MEMORIAL FALL CLASSIC (Trophy event) – August 28

A Triples event consisting of chosen teams that must include one newer member of the Club, and one intermediate member. Teams may not consist of more than one full Skip. Check posted Conditions of Play for composition of your team. If in doubt about your team's composition, call the convenor. 3x10 ends. No entry fee. BYO Lunch.

LEAGUES – THURSDAY EVENING AUSSIE PAIRS LEAGUE – June 2, July 7 and August 4

A pair's game in which the order of play within each team alternates between Skip and Lead. In the first end, the Lead throws the first two bowls, the Skip throws the next four and then the Lead throws the last two. For the second end, the players remain at their respective ends. The Skip now throws the first two bowls, the Lead throws the next four and then the Skip throws the last two. Play continues to alternate in this manner through the remainder of the game. Players experience both positions. The June and July teams will be made up by random draw. August will be chosen teams. Teams play on four consecutive Thursday evenings June, July and August. 14 ends. Entry fee is \$5.00 per person. Prizes according to number of entries.

LEAGUES – WEDNESDAY A.M. TRIPLES LEAGUE - June 1, July 6, August 3 start dates

Teams of Triples are randomly drawn for play on four consecutive Wednesday mornings. Games are 14 ends. Entry fee is \$5.00 per person. Prizes according to number of entries.

LLOYD SHEA – August 13

A one day competition between Tsawwassen and Ladner for the Lloyd Shea trophy. Competition alternates between the TLBC and Ladner greens. Format is Mixed Threes or Fours, depending on number of entrants. 3x10 ends. BYO Lunch. This year the Lloyd Shea will be held in Tsawwassen.

LOONIE and TOONIE DRAWS

Random draws are done to form teams of Triples. 12 ends are played. Scoring is done by total shot differentials. Prizes according to number of entries.

MAGGIE AND JIGGS (Trophy event) – July 23

Chosen partners, one male and one female. A one day event for up to 32 teams, morning and (possibly) afternoon draws of either 3x8 or 3x10 end games (dependent on number of registrants). No entry fee. BYO Lunch if there is just one draw.

MEN vs WOMEN – July1

A competition pitting Men vs Women. Depending on the number of entries, this event may be made up of Triples or Fours. 3x10 ends. Members may arrange a split game with another member of the same ranking. No entry fee.

PICK SIX TOURNAMENTS – September 10

The convenors will meet and create 4 teams, each team consisting of 6 players. The convenors will then appoint a captain for each team from those skips who have agreed to act as such. In advance of game day the captains must provide the convenors with their team slate for each game. There will be three (3) games and for each game the captain must assign a singles player, a pairs team and a triples team. No player can play more than one (1) singles game. Every player must play at least one (1) pairs game and one (1) triples game. \$5.00 entry fee. BYO Lunch.

Cutthroat Leagues – May to Mid July and Mid July to September (2 – 8 week leagues)

The leagues will be one group. (Skips and Thirds) and (Seconds and Leads) will be in separate draws in order to facilitate players only playing against like ranked players in groups of 3 or 4 depending on number of entries. The games will 14 ends for triples and ten ends for fours. Entry fee for the league is \$5.00 for the 8 weeks. Prizes will be awarded according to the number of entries. Rules of play and scoring will be covered in Conditions of Play.

Pony League – June 7, 14, 21 and 28

The league would be for members with 3 years or less bowling experience. Purpose is to introduce newer players to the League concept. Format would be Triple or Pairs depending on number of entries. No additional cost.
