

CUTTHROAT INTRODUCTION 2024

Format:

Maximum – 32 contestants. The first 32 to sign up are guaranteed a spot. If you cannot play on any given Friday please advise a Convenor so that a spare can be called in. Spares are listed in order of their sign up and will be called upon in order of their sign up. They will be phoned if we know there is a spot available. Fee \$5.00 (one time fee) to be paid no later than the second game. Games consist of 14 ends for 3 players and 10 ends for 4 players. Games are made up of 3 or 4 players each delivering 4 bowls.

Scoring:

Points for **groups of three**: 3 points for closes to the jack, 2 points for second closest and 1 point for third closest

Points for **groups of four**: 4 points for closest to the jack, 3 points for second closest, 2 points for third closest and 1 point for fourth closest

If playing in a game with 4 players, each player receives a 3 point bonus, added by the convenor.

Draw and Scoring:

There will be two separate Divisions

1. Division 1: comprise of Skips and Vice Skips (Red and Green tags)
2. Division 2: comprise of Seconds and Leads (Yellow and Blue tags)
3. First week no draw. Ranking is by when you signed up.
4. Subsequent weeks, the draw will be based on points scored in each division (i.e. – 1st, 2nd and 3rd place would play each other and so on down the list
5. Individual weekly points will be totalled and added to previous weekly points.
6. If a bowler is absent they will receive Missed Week Replacement points based on average of the bottom 1/3 of players scores for each division for that week
7. Bowlers must arrive 15 minutes before the posted time i.e. 6:15 pm to pick up their name tag and place on the appropriate rung of the ladder. The convenor will they assign lanes and positions of play by using the draw chips.
8. Two players in the group to keep score and one player can be the designated raker
9. Before the score cards are handed in they must be tallied. The total points for groups of three must add up to 84. The total points for groups of 4 must add up to 100. The scorecards must agree before they are handed in to the Convenor.
10. Prizes will be determined for division by number of players registered.
11. Because there is a long list of spares, we ask that those on the confirmed list commit to playing at least 5 of the 8 games. If you cannot do this you should be on the Spares list and we will replace you with a player who can commit to 5 games.
